UNLOCKING A SUSTAINABLE OCEAN ECONOMY

Oceans, seas and coastal areas are vital for humanity, playing crucial roles in biodiversity, climate regulation, oxygen production, carbon sequestration and food security. The Organization of Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) describes the ocean as the next "Great Economic Frontier" with potential for wealth creation, economic growth and innovation, contributing an estimated USD 1.5 trillion annually to the global economy, potentially rising to USD 3 trillion by 2030. Harnessing the blue economy can create livelihoods, alleviate poverty and improve living standards while safeguarding marine ecosystems. It supports sustainable development through climate-resilient infrastructure, renewable energy and ecotourism. Protecting and conserving marine resources is essential for the resilience and well-being of present and future generations, ensuring a sustainable and prosperous future.

PAKISTAN'S MARITIME POTENTIAL

With over 1000 kilometer coastline, Pakistan ranks 74th out of 142 coastal states, offering significant opportunities to develop its blue economy. The country's rich marine potential includes biodiversity, hydrocarbons, rare minerals, and various fisheries. Pakistan boasts the world's sixth-largest mangrove region, valued at USD 20 million annually. It also supports diverse marine life, such as 776 species of sharks, lobsters, sea snakes, shrimps, and non-living resources like beaches, bays, ports, and lagoons. Currently, the blue economy contributes an estimated USD 1 billion, or 0.5% of the country's GDP. Given Pakistan's labour-intensive nature, deep seashore, and strategic location at the mouth of the gulf, enhancing requisite assets and facilities can significantly boost its maritime sector.

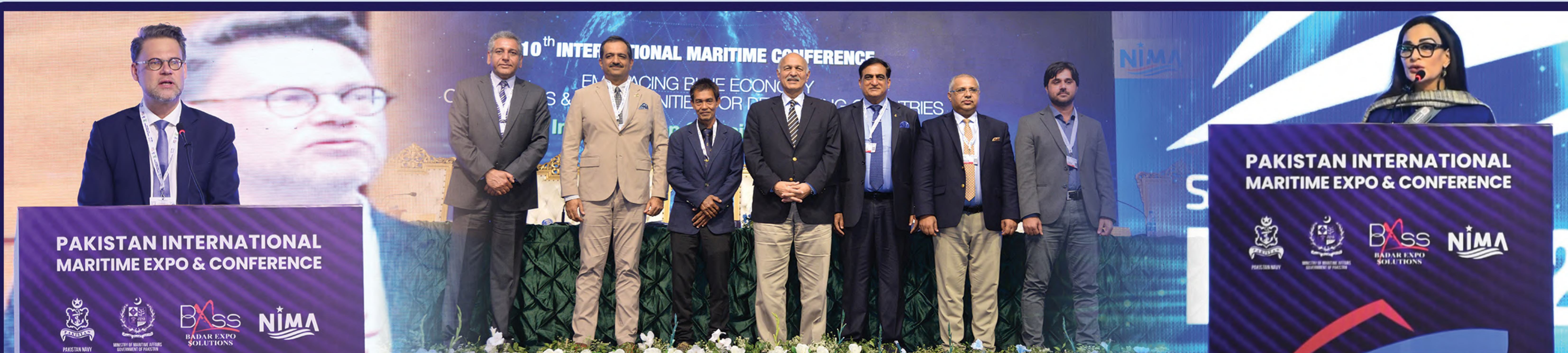

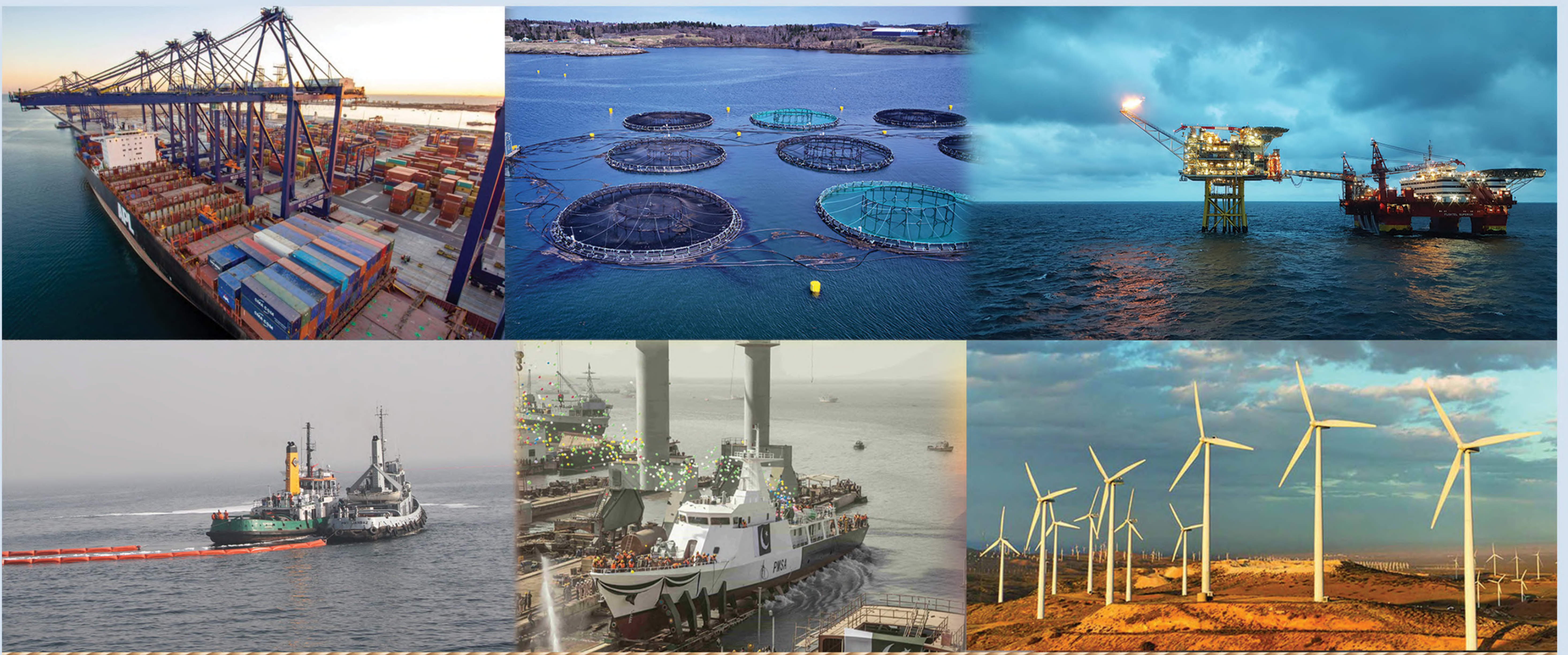

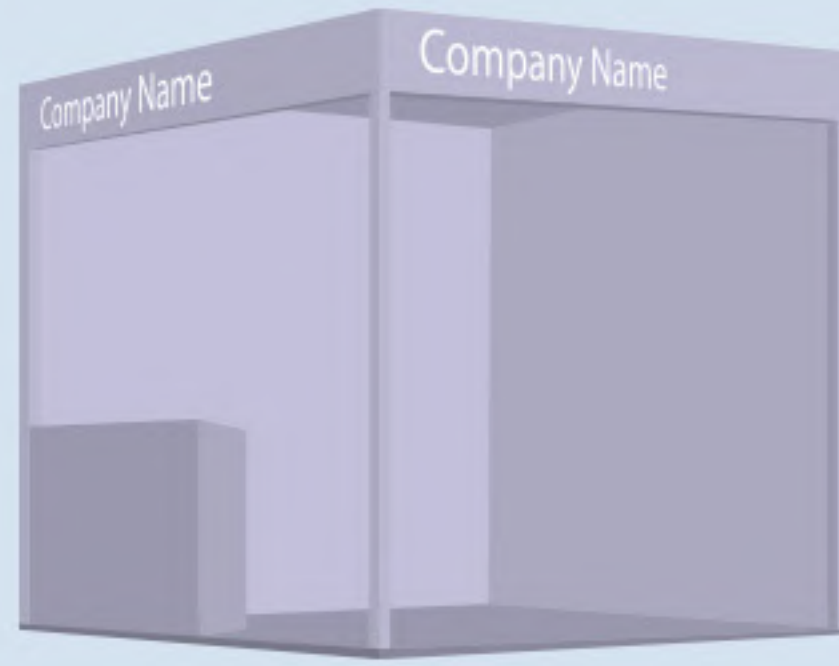
